

\* The floating holiday can be utilized, with manager approval, at any time throughout the calendar year for employees hired prior to July 15. When a scheduled holiday falls on an employee's scheduled day off, then the employee must take

either the previous or the next scheduled workday off as Holiday hours cannot be deferred. If an hourly employee is required to work on a holiday the employee will be paid for both the holiday

and hours worked. If a salaried employee is required to work on a holiday, the employee may take an

Employees must work their regularly scheduled workday prior to and immediately following the holiday or be on a scheduled vacation to receive holiday pay. Paid time off for holidays will not be counted as hours worked for the purpose of determining overtime.


